MSU runs winning streak to 10

Mavs use longball in Huskie sweep

ST. CLOUD — The Minnesota State baseball team cranked out 24 hits in two games Friday, extending its winning streak to 10 games with a North Central Conference doubleheader sweep over St. Cloud State.

The Mavericks won 11-0 and 6-2.

Offensively, Ryan Greene sparked the Mavericks with a 3-for-4, four-RBI performance that included his seventh home run of the season in Game 1.

Adam Sudbeck was 2 for 4 with two RBIs and two runs scored. He launched his ninth home run of the season. Dane Allen was 2 for 4 with two RBIs, and Nick Gonzalez had a solo home run.

Pitcher Jon Bjelland moved his record to 5-1, allowing two hits and striking out seven in six innings. Ben Kaus worked a scoreless seventh inning to close the game.

In Game 2, Ben King worked a four-hitter over six innings to pick up his fourth win of the season. King struck out four and walked one. Nick Fellman worked a perfect seventh with two strikeouts.

Dan Woodall led the offense, going 2 for 3 with a two-run home run. Allen was 2 for 4 with an RBI, and Greene was also 2 for 4.

The Mavericks (29-9, 9-1) will play a doubleheader with St. Cloud State at 1 p.m. Sunday at the MSU Baseball Complex in Mankato.
