Augustana hit a floating jumper from the right baseline with eight seconds remaining to guide the Vikings to a 72-71 victory over MSU this past Wednesday night.

The game was witnessed by a season-high 4,012 fans. The loss also snapped MSU's 16-game home winning streak, the 2nd longest in Taylor Center history.

Travis Nelson led MSU with 19 points and 9 rebounds, while junior Jefferson Mason scored 16 points and hauled in 8 rebounds.

The Mavericks (23-3, 16-3 NSIC) travel to the University of Mary Saturday for a 4 p.m. contest.

The Marauders are 15-11 overall and 11-8 in the NSIC and is ranked eighth in the Central Region.
