### ***MAVERICK MEN ARE TURNING A LOT OF HEADS!***

They tied a school record by running their record to 12-0 on December 19 with their win over Moorhead State.

After the Moorhead win they moved up to #2 in the country in Division II.

Jamal Staten has already received considerable recognition, and he is scheduled to appear in the next edition of *Sports Illustrated*.

Wednesday and Thursday, Dec. 29 and 30, they will participate in the Red Lyon Hotel-Fibromyalgia Classic in Monmouth, Ore. They will take on Central Washington (2-6) at 7:00 p.m. on Wednesday, Dec. 29, then will face host Western Oregon (5-3) on Thursday, Dec. 30, at 9:00 p.m. All game times listed are in Central Standard Time.

When they return to Minnesota they will play their first NCC conference game against UMD in Duluth on January 6. Their next home game will be January 8 when they meet Upper Iowa at Bresnan arena.

### ***MAVERICK WOMEN ARE MAKING STRIDES!***

Kelli Freeman captured several personal and school records fell when the women outclassed Viterbo on December 20, 92-50. She scored a career high 28 points. She was 9-of-19 from the floor, including 8-of-17 from beyond the three-point line. The 17 three-point field goal attempts is a school record for attempts in a game. With the eight three-pointers, Freeman has a total of 203 for her career making her just the second Maverick in school history to record 200 three-point field goals in a career. Freeman, now with 42 three-pointers on the season, is eighth on the school's single-season three-point field goals made chart.

The women are traveling to Monterey Bay, Calif., to participate in the Cal State-Monterey Bay Classic. MSU opens the event with the host Otters on Dec. 30

before facing #3 Drury University on Dec. 31. Thursday's contest is scheduled to begin at 4:00 p.m., Friday's game is slated for noon.

When they return to Minnesota they will open their conference schedule against UMD at Duluth on January 6. Their next appearance in Bresnan Arena will be on January 14<sup>th</sup> when they take on St. Cloud State.
