## MEN'S BASKETBALL

### MSU 67      Concordia-St. Paul 58

The 16th-rated Minnesota State men's basketball team won its third straight game as it downed Concordia-St. Paul 67-58 Saturday afternoon at Taylor Center.

Senior Gage Wooten led the Maverick attack Saturday afternoon as he dropped in a career-high 23 points, to go along with nine rebounds and five assists. He also connected on 80% of his shots from the field, including a 4-of-6 showing from beyond the arc.

Senior Connor O'Brien added 11 points, eight rebounds and matched his career-high with five blocks, a mark that he set earlier this season at Concordia-St. Paul. Junior Zach Monaghan tallied 11 points and seven helpers, while senior Tanner Adler dropped in 10 points as well.

As a team, MSU connected on 22-of-54 (.407) shots from the field, while passing out 15 assists and forcing 13 turnovers.

The Mavericks entered the second half leading by five and maintained a five-point lead throughout as they outscored the Golden Bears 37-33 in the second half to secure the 67-58 win.

Travon Mitchell and Terez Van Pelt led the Golden Bears with 17 points each.

The first half saw Minnesota State lead CU the majority of the way through. The Mavericks led by as many as seven points during the first half, but the Golden Bears were able to close within five at 30-25 heading into the locker room.

### MSU 80      Concordia-St. Paul 67

The No. 23 Minnesota State women's basketball team completed the season series sweep over No. 20 Concordia-St. Paul with an 80-67 win, pushing its home winning streak to 21 games.

The Mavericks and Golden Bears were all knotted up at 7-7 with 17:15 to play in the first half, before MSU would heat up and open a 15 point lead, 43-28 with 2:36 to play in the first half. CU responded with a 3-0 run to end the half, cutting the Maverick lead to 43-31 going into intermission.

Senior Ali Wilkinson (Blue Mounds, Wis.) paced the Mavericks with 18 first-half points, in addition to six rebounds, three steals and two assists. Freshman Britney Scherber (Bloomington, Minn.) added eight points off of the bench in the first 20 minutes.

Collectively, the Mavericks connected on 13-of-25 (37%) from the field, 4-of-10 (40%) from behind the arc and 13-of-17 (77%) from the charity stripe. The Golden Bears connected on 10-of-25 (40%) of their first half shots from the field, 2-of-8 (25%) from behind the arc and 9-of-12 (75%) from the charity stripe.

The Mavericks opened up a 50-35 lead with 15:35 to play, before the Golden Bears went on an 8-0 run cutting the lead to 50-43 in favor of MSU with 12:40 to play.

MSU would then find its rhythm as Wilkinson poured in 11 second half points to give the Mavericks the 80-67 win.
