Conference rewards three MSU student-athletes

MANKATO — Minnesota State University's Tim Matheson has been named the NCC Wrestler of the Week following three victories last week. The junior 174-pounder began the week with a 19-3 technical foul win over Daniel Midgett of Southern Illinois-Edwardsville.

He followed that with a 9-1 major decision over No. 4 ranked Corey Van Groll of Wisconsin-Parkside. He capped his week by pinning Central Missouri's Travis Barbarick.

The Mavericks (15-0-1, 1-0) are currently the No. 1 team in Division II.

In swimming, MSU's Ann Gusewelle has been named the NCC Women's Swimmer of the Week. She swept the 100- and 200-yard breast-stroke events in a dual with Northern Iowa.

She set a school record in the 100 and NCAA "B" cut and winning time of 1:06.69. She finished with a 2:29.89 in the 200 and was also part of the winning medley relay.

In track and field, MSU's high jumper Josh Robertson has been named the North Central Conference Male

Field Athlete of the Week.

Robertson won the high jump at the Carleton Intercollegiate Open Friday with a jump of 6-feet-6.

It is the second time this season Robertson has won the honor.
