Chicago is dazzling opener

Although successful as a Hollywood film, the stage version of *Chicago* has some exciting differences. Those will be on display Sept. 30-Oct. 3 & Oct. 7-10 as our season opener takes the stage. It is sponsored by HickoryTech Corporation.

The style of dance that is required for a successful production of *Chicago* is paramount to the authenticity of the show itself, says director/choreographer Paul Finocchiaro. Bob Fosse, who was born with his feet turned in “pigeon toed” and wore leg braces at an early age, was taken to ballet class by his mother to turn his legs out.

Fosse went on to a successful career as a dancer in Vaudeville, on Broadway and in film. When he got the opportunity to choreograph, the first thing he did was create

a style that felt comfortable for him. This involved turned-in feet, hunched over shoulders and isolated body parts. To this day, the “Fosse Style” has a trademark appearance.

This past summer as an Andreas Teaching Scholar, Finocchiaro had the great fortune to talk to some past and present members of the Broadway cast of *Chicago* and to see the latest production. Their insight into this production was invaluable, he says.

He also went to the city of Chicago, to the Cook County Jail, and to Los Angeles where he took tango lessons with one of the professionals from “Dancing With the Stars.” You will see the fruits of his research and learning in this production.
