**Position:** Campus Representative

**Benefits:** Monthly stipend of \$100 with a potential for increase depending on intern interest and organizational necessity. Reimbursements are available for any internship-related expenses such as printing, postage, phone, or travel mileage. NARAL Pro-Choice Minnesota will also work with your school to ensure academic credit.

**Organization:** NARAL Pro-Choice Minnesota is the largest statewide grassroots organization dedicated solely to protecting the right to choose. We work at the state and local level to ensure that Minnesota's women have access to safe, legal, and affordable reproductive healthcare. Internships with NARAL Pro-Choice Minnesota are a fun way to boost your resume while gaining valuable experience with a non-profit advocacy organization.

**Summary:** NARAL Pro-Choice Minnesota is looking for a creative, upbeat, resolutely pro-choice student to fill the position of Campus Representative. Campus Representatives play an important role in educating and activating their fellow students and community members about the ongoing importance of reproductive rights issues.

*NARAL Pro-Choice Minnesota prides itself on having flexibility with interns to develop an individualized plan that fits the needs and interests of the campus. Internship possibilities include: issue-based research, educational campaigns, electoral education, and campus organizing.*

### Responsibilities typically include:

- ✓ Participating in at least two community/campus outreach events per month (e.g. informational tabling, 3 minute classroom announcements, posterings);
- ✓ Planning and implementing a campus-based event (e.g. movie night, speakers) for: National Young Women's Day of Action (Oct), anniversary of the *Roe v. Wade* decision (Jan 22); National Day of Appreciation for Abortion Providers; & National Back Up Your Birth Control Day (March 20);
- ✓ Recruiting students for a state-wide pro-choice lobby day in St. Paul in the spring;
- ✓ Participating in regular phone/e-mail communications with staff for organizational support;
- ✓ Finding your replacement; and
- ✓ Other activities as the need arises (e.g. political activism, legislative campaigns, media watch, writing a letter to the editor).

**Qualifications:** This internship spans the academic year and is performed on your college campus and in the surrounding community, depending on the intern's interests. A commitment to reproductive rights, strong communication and interpersonal skills are required. Interns must be able to work independently with regular (but long distance) supervision and assistance. Experience working with campus (or community) -based groups and/or volunteers is a plus, but not required.
