Welcome to the CDC.

The Career Development Center at Minnesota State University, Mankato helps employers post jobs and internships, search for candidate resumes, and receive applications online. We also offer comfortable, professional facilities for on-campus interviews.

Here's how to work with the CDC:

Register with www.mavjobs.com.

Mavjobs is a free, innovative online system for connecting over 19,000 students and graduates with part-time and seasonal jobs, internships, and entry-level employment after graduation. Employers may also email their job postings to jobs@mnsu.edu for posting by CDC staff. Mavjobs requires a brief registration, which commits employers to the CDC's terms and conditions (online at www.mnsu.edu/cdc/employers/postingjobs/terms.html).

Meet with students and graduates.

The CDC hosts a number of job fairs and career events annually and invites employers to hold information sessions and conduct interviews on campus. Mavjobs allows employers to prescreen applications, request

interview schedules, and reserve rooms for interviews and information sessions. Employers receive complimentary parking and lunch with a CDC staff member and departmental faculty on interview days.

To reserve a date for on-campus recruiting or for an information session, log on to your mavjobs.com account and click on "Create New Schedule Request" or "Request New Info Session" under Quick Links on your employer homepage.
