### TIMELINE

#### Election Timeline

- March 17<sup>th</sup> - Candidacy application made available
- March 22<sup>nd</sup> at 2:00 PM and March 28<sup>th</sup> at 11:00 AM – Rules readings
  - Rules readings will NOT be required of individual candidates; however, parties must have at least one (1) member attend a reading to be scheduled with the elections commissioner or their designee, or an open rules reading meeting
  - Meetings will be held in the student government conference room (CSU 273) and on Zoom.
- March 25<sup>th</sup> – Campaigning Begins
  - Candidates may begin to hang posters and utilize social media
- March 28<sup>th</sup> – Filing deadline for Presidential and Vice-Presidential Candidates
- April 6<sup>th</sup> – Presidential and Vice-Presidential Debate (and Fee Increase Open Forum, if necessary)
  - Location TBD, with Virtual Capability– 12:00 pm
- April 4<sup>th</sup> – Filing deadlines for all other Candidates (Senate and Boards)
- April 11<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> – Election
  - Voting open from 8:00 a.m. on Monday, April 11 – 6:00 p.m. on Tuesday, April 12, at [www.mnsu.edu/voting](http://www.mnsu.edu/voting)
- April 14<sup>th</sup> – All campaign materials must be removed.
