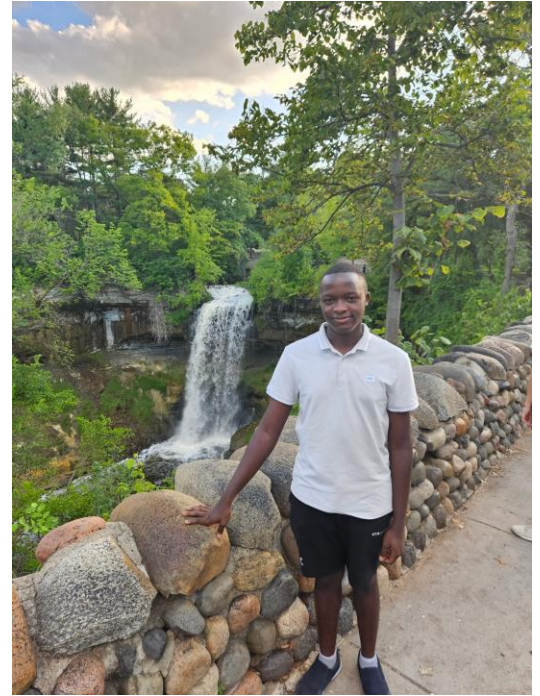
Tracy Swartzendruber - Independent
