



POSTER MAKER

TYPE:

Energizer

GROUP SIZE:

Any

MATERIALS:

Paper, Markers, Art Supplies

INTRODUCTION:

This activity will allow group members to work together to create a visual representation of the group.

DESCRIPTION:

Give the group a large piece of paper. Instruct group members to create a poster that represents the group, a special project, or a theme. Use the poster at special events or in a central office that is used by the group. Discuss the process and the finished product.

PROCESSING:

- What role did you play within your team?
- How does the poster represent everyone in your group?
- Who was the leader of the group and why?
- How did you decide what to use to represent the group?

VARIATIONS:

Impose special circumstances on individual group members such as: blindfold a group member, hinder the use of a group member's arms, etc.

OUTCOMES:

- Builds fun and enthusiasm
- Creates group synergy
- Inclusion of group group members

REMEMBER:

- Introduce the exercise
- Explain it thoroughly
- Process it completely
