PARKING INFORMATION FOR RESIDENCE HALL STUDENTS AND GUESTS

GREEN PERMIT HOLDERS:

Green permits are for students living in the residence halls only. Be sure to register each vehicle using the parking permit with the Campus Hub. It is recommended that residents check their vehicle every 24 hours.

<u>Different Car here?</u> If you leave your permit at home or switch vehicles, you must get a temporary permit from Campus Hub between 8:00 A.M.-5:00 P.M. Monday—Thursday; 9:30 A.M.-5:00 P.M. Friday. After these hours, call Security at 507-389-2111. Only one vehicle may be on campus per Green permit.

Lot Full? Overflow parking is in Lot 1. Green permits are valid only in green lots identified on permit.

Abuse -\$100 fine - A \$100 fine will be levied against those using their status as a residence hall student to purchase and/or obtain a permit for a non-residence hall student or anyone fraudulently representing themselves as a residence hall student.

CAR FOR A DAY OR TWO?

Residents without a permit needing overnight parking - may purchase Lot 1 - one week temporary permits at the Campus Hub during business hours for \$5 a day or \$20 a week. If the Hub is closed, call 507-389-2111 (available 24 hours year round) and Security will direct you where to park and take information from you regarding your vehicle.

FREE PARKING

Purple permitted areas have free parking between 6:30 P.M. and 2:00 A.M. and weekends 6 A.M. to 2:00 A.M.

Green permitted areas and yellow guest stalls are the ONLY overnight parking and are open free from noon Friday through Sunday at 6:00 P.M.

Gold stalls are free from 6:30 P.M. to 2:00 A.M. Monday—Thursday, 4 P.M.-2:00 A.M. Friday and 6:00 A.M.-2:00 A.M. weekends.

Remember no parking between 2:00 A.M. in purple/free lots/gold/facilities services/vendor/timed stalls, or any streets.

TREAT YOUR GUESTS WELL

All guests (non Minnesota State Mankato affiliated) staying with a vehicle on campus require a temporary yellow guest permit, valid for 24-hours issued from the residence hall front desks. All information is required on the permit. Yellow guest permits are valid in marked yellow auest stalls or in the overflow parking in Lot 1 only. Residents are responsible for any guests who visit the campus. When having a guest visitor on campus, be sure to obtain a parking permit.

Responsibility of Residence Hall Guests: As a matter of policy, residence hall students are responsible to ensure that their guests follow campus parking policies. Where a residence hall student (sponsor) has assisted in procuring a guest overnight residence hall parking permit for their visitors, should that visitor then illegally park, the residence hall student shall be held liable for parking related fines assuming nonpayment on the part of the violator.

Overnight parking? Same as weekend parking below.

Yellow guest stalls full? If all close-in Yellow permit guest stalls are full, overflow parking is in LOT 1 ONLY.

Yellow Permits are for whom? Yellow guest permits are for guests only. (NON-Minnesota State Mankato affiliated) Abusers will be ticketed, towed, or autoclamped.

Front Desk Closed? And you need a guest parking permit? Call 507-389-2111 (available 24 hours year round) and Security will direct you where to park and when and how to obtain a parking permit.

THANKSGIVING WINTER/ SPRING **BREAKS**

Only residence hall students with a contract in the residence halls will be allowed to have their vehicle on campus. If you have no residence hall contract during the break, your vehicle may be ticketed/towed for abandoned vehicle at your expense.

MOVING OUT?

Take your Green permit to the Cashiers Office within ten working days from termination of your residence hall contract at which time a prorated refund will be issued. Permits may only be sold by the University and NOT offered for resale or exchange between, among or by individuals. Use of non-returned Green permit will result in a \$100 citation/autoclamp.

VEHICLE STALLED?

If your vehicle is stalled and you are parked illegally, you must notify Security immediately at 507-389-2111!

QUICK STOPS?

Use the meter stalls. If full, you may need to wait for one to open up. Meter stalls are for loading and unloading purposes with a 30 minute maximum limit. Meters are 15 minutes for a 25¢ and 30 minutes for 50¢. Parking at a yellow curb and/or using your flashers is not legal parking anywhere!
