Pre-Pay Your Health Insurance:


WHY PRE-PAY YOUR HEALTH INSURANCE?

- 1. Pre-paying your insurance will allow you earlier access to class registration. Students are not allowed to register for courses UNTIL they have paid their health insurance fee for the semester.
- 2. Your health insurance will be effective immediately upon arrival in the U.S.

HOW DO I MAKE THE PAYMENT?

You will log into your e-services to make the insurance prepayment.

- 2. Select Bills and Payment (left side list area)
- 3. Select Make Prepayment (either on the left side list or center section)
- 4. Scroll down list to Intern'l Insurance Fall and click select
