## What Classes Can PSEO Students Register For?



PSEO students are given an incredible opportunity to take university courses at no cost. Given this opportunity, students should understand the importance of taking purposeful classes.

## What Classes Can PSEO Students Register For?

 It is important for PSEO students to know that they can register for any class a tuition-paying student can register for, with a few exceptions. Please watch our video on <u>What Classes Can't PSEO Students Register For</u> to learn more about these exceptions.

#### 2. PSEO students can register for:

- Up to 18 undergraduate credits per semester.
  - Most PSEO students will register for between 8-10 credits/semester.
- 100-200 level general education courses.
- Classes that do not exceed \$100 in additional fees.



## What Classes Should PSEO Students Prioritize?

- 1. A student's first priority should be to take **required classes for high school graduation.** Students should be meeting with their high school guidance counselor prior to class registration so that they understand what courses they should be taking.
- Once a student has fulfilled all of their high school graduation requirements, they can start taking general education courses and/or classes that are intended towards their major of interest. This is something the PSEO Department can help students narrow down.

- To prepare for the upcoming semester, PSEO students should meet with their high school guidance counselor prior to registration to determine what classes they still need to take for high school.
- PSEO students should prioritize these high school classes above other course selections they may have in mind.
- Students should start thinking about their potential major and where they want to go to college when they graduate from high school. These are important questions a PSEO advisor will ask.
