For PLUS loans, please include the Parent Borrower's Social Security number as well as the student's Social Security number.

Many colleges/universities use social security numbers and birthdates for student identification purposes on student records. Providing this information is voluntary. If you do not provide these numbers, your request may not be processed. This data is requested for purposes of administration.
