Contest Rules:

1. Participants must use the template that is provided by the Kearney Center. A printed copy is attached. The template can also be downloaded at <http://www.mnsu.edu/international/festival>.
2. Children must submit their art pieces to their community organization by March 15. Community organizations will submit to Kearney Center staff member by March 22.
3. All art pieces must include the child's name, age and a short description of the picture. Community organizations should also include a roster of children's names, parents' names and contact information.
4. Postcards can be drawn in pencil, crayon, marker or any other medium of choice. However, children cannot go beyond the limits of the postcard outline.

Contest Deadline: March 22, 2019

Contest winners will be announced at the Mankato Area International Festival on April 7, 2019 from 11AM-3PM.
