3. Recommendations of the Parking Advisory Committee
 - **Capital Improvement Plan for Summer 2007** - \$374,898. Includes paving and lighting of Lot 23 (aka “Free Lot”).
 - Proposed Income and Spending Plans for 2007-08.
 - No rate increase to existing permit types.
 - Create a **\$40 Academic Year permit for Lot 23** to aid in cost recovery of improvements and eliminate non-MSU community members from using lot.
 - Increase **Lot 4 Paylot Hourly Rates to \$3 first hour/\$2 per hour thereafter**. Existing rates since 2000-01: \$2 first hour/\$1 thereafter.
 - **Raise existing \$15 standard parking violation to \$25 for those electing to illegally park in a Gold permit stall**. Illegally parking in Purple and Orange stalls would remain at the \$15 level. Paybox rate for Lot 21 Purple or Orange stalls would remain at \$1 per hour. Rate change is designed to encourage existing MSU permit holders to park in their permit stalls during bad weather days as well as to encourage MSU community members who don't own a permit to buy a permit. Guests and visitors, especially conference goers, have problems getting into the 180 Paylot stalls when they are full of MSU people.
 - Scooters & Mini-Bikes – **Road licensed machines to be treated as motorcycles requiring MSU permits**. Amend existing Article V. Section H parking handbook standard deleting reference to “125 cc or larger”. Enlarge existing motorcycle parking zones to accommodate scooters and mini-bikes which are now parking at bike racks. Amendment would require scooters and mini-bikes to buy \$60 permit (or \$30 with other MSU permit).
