## **Recycle These Items**





- Aluminum containers and cans
- Plastic containers #1 #7
- Glass beverage containers
- Paper, newspaper, junk mail, greeting cards
- Magazines
- Phone books
- Paperback books
- Paperboard boxes (pizza boxes can be recycled as long as there is very little food and/or grease contamination)
- Cardboard boxes (flatten and place next to paper recycling bin)



- Styrofoam cups, plates and/or packaging
- Wraps, film or plastic 6-pack holders
- Coffee filters, tea bags
- Candy and gum wrappers
- Potato chip bags
- Gift paper, tissue paper or sticker release paper
- Bathroom waste paper
- Photos, slides, transparencies
- Incandescent light bulbs
- Disposable razors

#### <u>Other</u>

- Plastic shopping bags (turn in to any HyVee store)
- Glass test tubes, beakers, etc. (place in specially-marked containers in labs)
- Needles (place in sharps containers in restrooms)
