Minnesota State System Guided Planning Scenario Framework

Scenario A

No restrictions on movement or size of gatherings

Scenario B

Restrictions on movement and size of gatherings, but no stay at home order in place

Scenario C

Significant restrictions on movement and gatherings, with stay at home order in place for part or all of the semester

- Phase 1 Short-term (May-August, 2020)
- Phase 2 Mid-term (August-December, 2020)
- Phase 3 Long-term (January, 2021-)
